AMERICAN EAGLE INCREASES SAN JUAN-MARTINIQUE ROUTE TO DAILY SERVICE

SAN JUAN, Puerto Rico – American Eagle announced today that it will expand service between San Juan, Puerto Rico, and Fort-de-France, Martinique, effective Feb. 1, 2007.

The airline will increase its service to seven days a week, up from the existing four days a week, using the ATR72 turbo-prop aircraft with capacity for 64 passengers. The additions will be single flights on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays to accompany the existing service on the remaining days. American Eagle began the route on Dec. 15, 2005.

“American Eagle is pleased with the success of our San Juan-Martinique service and appreciates the assistance of the local governments to help us develop the route,” said Ed Criner, President of Executive Airlines, which flies as American Eagle in the Caribbean, Florida and the Bahamas. “Expanding the route to daily service will give more passengers access to the beautiful beaches and culture on Martinique, while giving passengers from Martinique improved opportunities to reach American Eagle and American destinations from our San Juan hub.”
